RE: AB 2293 as Amended April 10, 2014 – Support

Dear Assembly Member Bonilla:

On behalf of the California Airports Council (CAC), we write to express our strong support of AB 2293, which would require a Transportation Network Company's (TNC) insurance policy to apply as the primary coverage in the event of a loss or injury sustained while the driver was providing TNC services.

The CAC comprises the 34 commercial service airports throughout the state, serving over 170 million passengers annually. It also consists of two of the nation's ten largest airports, Los Angeles International and San Francisco International.

Last September, the California Public Utilities Commission required TNCs seeking to operate on airport property to conform to airport permitting requirements. As our airports finalize permits for TNC operation, they would like to ensure that passengers and drivers are fully protected should an incident occur while TNC services are provided. We believe primary coverage is necessary to eliminate insurance gaps which compromise the protection of patrons.

For the reasons mentioned above, the CAC supports AB 2293.
